ACT To amend the Roads Ordinance, 1968, so as to empower the responsible Member to extend the term of office of members of district road boards; and to extend the application of the Roads Ordinance, 1968, throughout the Province. 5 RE IT ENACTED by the Provincial Legislature of the Free State Province as follows: 10 (English text signed by the Premier.) (Assented to 10 May 1996) 15 Amendment of section 28 of Ordinance 4 of 1968 20 Section 28 of the Roads Ordinance, 1968, is amended by the substitution for 1. subsection (2) of the following subsection: On the expiration of the period for which they were elected or appointed, "(2)members of a board shall continue in office until their successors have been 25 elected or appointed, but not for a period longer than [six] eight months: Provided that the responsible Member may from time to time extend such period.". 30 Extension of application of Ordinance 4 of 1968 2. The Roads Ordinance, 1968, shall apply throughout the Province. 35 Short title

This Act shall be called the Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1996, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 May 1996.
