The Free State is getting a "green facelift" to address the apartheid era spatial plans of municipalities. Thirty nine (39) kilometres in twelve (12) towns will be a beehive of activities planting a total of 15 000 plants. Calling all the communities to support the programme, Premier Ace Magashule says, "Our people have not been looking after those trees that were planted in the past. So we are saying to people, you are responsible for your own health and the outlook of where you stay".

The greening project will be in the following towns: Parys/ Tumahole, Warden/ Ezenzeleni, Heilbron/Phiritona, Virginia/Meloding, Frankfort/Namahadi, Cornelia/ Ntswanatsatsi, Kroonstad/Marabastad, Sasolburg/Zamdela, Ventersburg/Mamahabane, Viljoenskroon/ Rammulotsi, Trompsburg/Madikgetla, Botshabelo.
